## Exhibitor Information

- Multiple exhibitors may be entered on one entry form, and you will be given an option to “Add Exhibitor” after completing the section for Exhibitor 1.
- If this is this exhibitor’s first time competing at the VRH World Show, select “yes.” Otherwise, select “no.”
- Enter the Exhibitor’s name exactly as it appears on the AQHA membership card, including any middle initial, middle name, or maiden name.
- Select the Membership type from the drop down menu: Amateur, Open, or Youth
- Enter the AQHA membership ID number and expiration date (formatted mm/dd/yyyy)
  - This is not required for NRSHA-only, non-AQHA horse entries.
  - If an Amateur exhibitor has a life membership with an Amateur upgrade, please list the expiration date of the amateur upgrade.

## W-9 and Tax Identification

FAQ


- In all Open classes, the Owner (as recorded with AQHA) must submit a W-9 to be issued any payouts.
  - For example, if the horse is owned by Joe Smith, the W-9 information must include Joe Smith's individual social security number, and Smith Quarter Horses LLC cannot be the payee of any payout checks.
- In all Amateur and Youth classes, the Exhibitor must submit a W-9 to be issued any payouts.
  - The exhibitor must submit his/her social security number, regardless of age in youth classes.
- The name listed on the W-9 must match the income tax return exactly.
  - For example, if Jane Doe files her taxes with her maiden name, Jane Smith, but her AQHA membership is listed Jane Doe, she must put Jane Smith on the W-9 section of the entry form.
- If the horse is entered in Open and Amateur/Youth classes, two separate W-9 sections will be required on the entry form.







## Stall Information




- All horses must either reserve a stall or pay a \$65 haul-in fee.
- If you selected “Yes, this horse has already been entered in the 2023 VRH World Show” at the beginning of the entry form, the Stall Information options will be hidden. If you need to add stalls to an existing entry, please select “no”.


- ONE name must be entered on the Stall Block by all exhibitors that wish to stall together.
  - Example: Joe Smith, Suzy Rogers, & John Bowen want to stall together. To ensure they are all placed together, Joe, Suzy, and John all list “Joe Smith” for their stalling agent with Joe’s phone number on their stall reservations.
- Select the number of stalls to be paid for on this entry form.
  - Note: Partial stalls or tack stalls are not able to be split and must be done on your own. If there are 3 horses in your group, but you need 4 total stalls, one entry form will need to pay for 2 stalls (the horse and the tack stall).
- Enter the date of arrival and date of departure.
  - Note: Sponsors may move in starting at noon on Saturday, June 17<sup>th</sup>. General arrival is not permitted before noon on Sunday, June 18.
- Notate any special requests. Requests are not guaranteed, but the AQHA team will do their best to accommodate.


