Led the early founders of the National Versatility Ranch Horse Assoc. in its organization in 2007. Active in its early growth -
for example:

- Exhibited two horses to NVRHA Champions and Supreme Champions.
- Exhibited Docs Second Best to the Legend Award.
- Runner Up All-Around Colorado State Versatility Ranch Horse Championship 2006(42 Finalist)
- Advanced Division Champion at the 2012 NVRHA National Championship.
- 2014 NVRHA Horseman of the year.
- Conducted over 30 NVRHA “new start” events in 13 states which led to the establishment of 6 NVRHA Affiliates.
